You will be introduced, by the emcee, as you take the stage in a formal dress of your choosing. There is no admissino charge for audience members attending Formal Wear

ATTIRE RULES

PRINCESS, JR. PRE-TEEN, & PRE-TEEN

- A formal style dress that is appropriate for your age and personality.
- Your dress can be any length orstyle.
- No noticeable make-up.
- Not hats or bare midriffs.
 - Shoes should be small heels or flats that compliment your dress.

JR. TEEN, TEEN, MISS, ELITE

- A prom or formal wear dress that is appropriate for your age and personality.
- · Your dress can be any length or style.
- No hats.
- · Shoes should compliment your dress.

ESCORTS

Escorts are needed for all age groups, except for Miss (ages 19-24) and Elite (25-39). Escorts may be any family member or friend.

Escorts are only needed during the Formal Wear Competition. During the Final Show the State Finalist is presented on stage alone and at that time, your escort would be part of the audience. So, your escort will need a ticket to the Final Show, if they wish to attend the Final Show

ATTIRE FOR ESCORTS: Something that compliments the contestant's formal dress. T-shirts, jeans, shorts would NOT be considered appropriate attire.

REHEARSAL

During Pageant Weekend each Sate Finalist will attend a rehearsal so they may practice walking with their escort.

Escorts are encouraged to attend this rehearsal, but it is not required.









SCORING

- Scoring is based on the judges' overall impression, and the finalists' ability to command attention with her poise and personality!
- Judges are looking for a representative who is wearing appropriate attire, and is confident and comfortable on stage.

YOU BRING

- Complimenting jewelry if applicable.
 Emcee card (located in your Pageant Paperwork). This card will be submitted at Pageant Check-In.
